Multiple Monitors

Have you ever wanted to connect more than one monitor to your computer?

Many computer users today have two or three monitors connected to the same computer.

This can easily be done with today's full featured video cards and/or a wide variety of cables, adapters and connectors.

If you want to have more than one monitor on your computer, start by looking on the back of your computer tower for any video output ports.

The common types of video port are the 15 pin VGA port, usually blue, the 24 pin DVI port usually white, and the newer HDMI port and the latest called the DisplayPort. (DisplayPort kind of looks like an HDMI port but with one flat side)

If you find more than one of these ports on your computer then you have all you need to connect a second monitor. They don't have to be the same type of port and usually aren't.
